Introduction

An essential element to experiencing spiritual renewal within a church body is a vibrant and meaningful life of prayer that shapes its culture. This life of prayer emanates from each soul that is abiding in Christ and enjoying His presence within their daily routines. It also permeates every aspect of church life, as the people of God gather intentionally and expectantly to express adoration for the goodness and greatness of God. A praying church is a humble, gracious, and thankful church, especially when their prayers are guided by meditation on the Word of God. When the people of God seek the face of God, listen to the voice of God, and respond to the Spirit of God, He brings conviction and courage to live with wholehearted devotion to Him and one another. This culture of prayer is life-giving and unifies the church in their God-given mission and empowers their gospel proclamation. **Does this describe you and your church?**

Spiritual renewal is a continual and gracious work of God. *"His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us to his own glory and excellence"* (1 Peter 2:3 ESV). **It is also a pursuit!** The practice of spiritual disciplines causes one to experience the power and presence of God for life transformation.

⁵ For this very reason, make every effort to supplement your faith with virtue, and virtue with knowledge, ⁶ and knowledge with self-control, and self-control with steadfastness, and steadfastness with godliness, ⁷ and godliness with brotherly affection, and brotherly affection with love. ⁸ For if these qualities are yours and are increasing, they keep you from being ineffective or unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁹ For whoever lacks these qualities is so nearsighted that he is blind, having forgotten that he was cleansed from his former sins (2 Peter 1:5-9).

Do you long to see your church **pursuing Christ** with joy, **pursuing community** within the body of Christ with loyal love, and **pursuing Christ's commission** to make disciples with steadfast devotion? **Let's make every effort** to pursue a culture of spiritual renewal. May these qualities increase and bear fruit in your 40-day journey.

The purpose of this Toolkit and Planning Guide is to equip the local church with resources and best practices to organize and implement a 40-day prayer strategy to cultivate a culture of prayer. The 40 Day Prayer Guide is simply a discipleship tool to model spiritually renewing disciplines, but it must be wielded intentionally and effectively to see desired results. This rises and falls on leadership.

The pastor must champion this initiative and catalyze this movement by casting a vision of renewed disciples having a greater Kingdom impact. He must prepare the elders, deacons, and ministry team leaders, so the 40-day journey is embraced wholeheartedly. This includes forming a **Renew Team** within the church to pursue strategic values with humility and courage. Together, they will seek to integrate the 40-days into all areas of church life, model it, and be the captains of communication.

Getting Started

1. The pastor is encouraged to engage with the Renew Montana Champion in his region. The Renew Champion can serve as a guide in the process and offer weekly coaching and encouragement. This engagement will activate the Renew Montana Network to earnestly pray for and encourage each pastor and church seeking renewal. Let's pursue renewal together!
2. The pastor is encouraged to thoughtfully explore the resources of the 40-day Toolkit and dream. What can God do with a church fully submitted to Him? What is the purpose of the 40-days in your church? What are you pursuing?
3. The pastor is encouraged to experience at-least the first 10 days of the 40 Days of Prayer by utilizing the prayer guide. His personal experience of mediation, reflection, responding, and journaling will allow him to cast vision with ministry leaders and the church. Why is the 40-days essential to your mission?
4. Once the pastor fully embraces the 40-days of prayer strategy, it is suggested he form a **Renew Team** with ministry leaders in his church. The Renew Team can explore the Toolkit, dream, and experience at least 10 days of the prayer guide together. It is suggested to connect the Renew Team members with a "Battle Buddy" from within the team and share/pray for at least 10 minutes daily. A quick phone call works. Share what the Lord is revealing and pray together using the prayer prompts to engage the Scripture together.

If desired, steps 3 and 4 can be combined.

5. Once the Renew Team has embraced the process, they will sign the Pastor/Church Covenant with the Renew Montana Champion. This is an editable document. The Renew Team will determine their level of commitment to implementing the suggested steps. Once signed, it's time to start planning, organizing, training, and communicating.

FASTING

It is encouraged to consider a fasting component to the 40-days. Some may fast a meal a day or one day a week for focused prayer. Others may fast three or more days at a time to break a spiritual stronghold in their life. Fasting was prominent in the Old Testament and early Church. It is not widely practiced today. This will require additional teaching (see "Resources"). There are examples of fasts in the life of Moses, Nehemiah, Daniel, Esther, and Joel, with repentance a key element. Jesus taught on fasting in Matthew 6:16-18. Luke mentions Anna fasting and praying (Luke 2:37). The church in Antioch was fasting and praying (Acts 13:1-3). There is power in fasting!

Renew Team Planning Process

Once the team is selected and completes the covenant, it's time to plan. Depending on the size of your church, the promotion and training process can take 30 – 60 days.

1. Calendar

- a. Set a start date to begin 40 days. _____
- b. Set a date for the Concert of Prayer (if desired). _____
- c. Set a date to train worship/music leader. _____
- d. Set a date for Small Group Leaders Training . _____
- e. Set a date for the Celebration Gathering. _____

2. Communication

- a. Cast vision – What is the purpose of the 40-days of prayer? Are there strategic goals you are working towards?
- b. Make Sunday announcements and send weekly emails from the Pastor or Renew Team to galvanize the movement with at least 1 month lead time.
- c. Develop graphics, PowerPoint slides, etc. for the campaign.
- d. Create bulletin inserts and posters.
- e. Cast vision for a personal covenant and a “Battle Buddy”.
- f. Distribute personal covenant templates and Battle Buddy Cards prior to launch.
- g. Send weekly emails during the campaign with encouragement and challenges.
- h. Share testimonies on Sunday and in small groups.

3. Train Leaders

- a. Meet with Worship/Music Team to discuss music, prayer, Scripture integration on Sunday mornings (see “Resources”)
- b. Organize spiritually mature leaders to lead the Scripture and prayer times each Sunday. See examples in “Resources”.
- c. Meet with Small Group Leaders to cast vision, teach them how to pray Scripture. Guide them in leading reflection questions and testimonies. Train leaders to utilize the prayer prompts and encourage each person to pray.

Host a **Concert of Prayer** to launch the 40-days and ask each person to sign a personal covenant, making commitments for the 40-days.

Organize small groups (and/or Sunday School classes) and prepare small group leaders (SS teachers) with training and resources for weekly discussion and prayer prompts.

Organize "Battle Buddies" for the 40-days, with each person making a connection for 10 minutes at least 3 times per week, or once a week for 30 minutes.

Coordinate and train the Worship/Music Leaders to integrate the 40-days into the Sunday service with a dedicated time of Scripture-fed and Spirit-led prayer each week.

Integrate the 40-days into sermon preparation with a dedicated series on prayer, fasting, repentance, submission, spiritual disciplines, spiritual renewal, etc.

Encourage the church to share testimonies with one another throughout the 40-days.

Share a weekly email encouragement (from the Pastor/Renew Team) to the church in their 40-day commitments with a personal testimony.

Print the 40-day guide for those who want a hard copy.

Send a daily email with that day's digital version of the prayer guide to the church family with a brief word of encouragement from the pastor or Renew Team.

Host a **Celebration Gathering** after the 40 days using the Celebration Guide to explore next steps in renewal.

A Concert of Prayer

One way to set the tone for 40-days of focused prayer is to launch it with a Concert of Prayer. This worship gathering integrates worship songs, scripture, and worship-based prayers to model Scripture-fed and Spirit-led prayers. The timing and format are flexible. It can be a special gathering away from normal service times or embedded into Sunday morning. Prayer takes the priority! Allow your Renew Team to give input and design a worship experience that emphasizes your desired goals and stated values.

¹⁵ And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful. ¹⁶ Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God. ¹⁷ And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him. Format

A concert of prayer has multiple elements of focused prayer. With each element, Scripture is central, and music is sung as prayers. The Pastor is the worship leader for this guided experience, but mature believers can be utilized throughout the service to lead prayer prompts and/or pray the scripture passages. Music can be played softly throughout to enhance the atmosphere with song leaders selecting songs which match the themes of the Scriptures. The prayer times can be done individually, in small groups, or as a large group.

There are a variety of potential formats to create a flow for the prayer time. Each can take 10-15 minutes. One model is Remember, Rejoice, Repent, & Renew. The ACTS model is Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, & Supplication. You can also create three segments with an emphasis on Pursuing Christ, Pursuing Christ's Community, and Pursuing Christ's Commission. You can integrate these or create your own.

God speaks! Take time to cultivate intimacy with Christ in your prayers during each segment and let God speak through His Word while you pray. An open Bible is a wonderful prayer tool whether with Psalms of praise, admonishments, exhortations, or encouragement. Read the Scripture aloud so all can hear. Focus on key words in the text that prompt the heart and pray them reflectively. Ask, is this truth principle true in me? Let the Spirit of God lead and if there is a segment that becomes more fervent with tears, don't interrupt it just to keep on schedule. Take the church before the throne of God and consider how the Scripture leads one to pursue Christ (magnify), pursue community with the body of Christ (edify), and pursue our commission (multiply).

40 Days of Prayer Celebration

Host a church-wide meal to celebrate the movement of God in your church. Take time for singing, sharing testimonies, praying, and responding. Ask probing questions that challenge the church in their God-given mission and capture the momentum of the 40-days. This may include “table talk” questions during the meal, or large sticky note tear sheets to record responses that are shared. Examples are given below.

- How has the 40-days impacted your walk with Christ?
- What are ways we can foster deeper connection with Christ as a church?
- Based on your 40-day experience, what is Christ leading you to do?
- Has God led you to personal repentance in any area of life?

Pursuing Christ's Community

- How have you experienced loyal love and unity with our church family?
- How can we build on this momentum and grow closer?
- In what ways do we glorify Christ as a spiritual community?
- What must we do as a church family to better reflect the glory of God?

Pursuing Christ's Commission

- How has the Lord challenged you in your faithful obedience?
- In what ways are we making a positive impact on our town?
- How can we better serve the people in our town?
- How effective are we in disciple-making?
- How are we impacting the nations with the Gospel?

Renew Team Follow-up

After the 40 Day Celebration, gather the Renew Team. Review the responses of the church and consider next steps with these questions.

- Are the mission and vision of the church clear?
- Does our church structure reflect our mission and vision?
- What are clear goals that need be established to refocus and realign the church to her mission and vision?
- Do we want to take another step with the Renew Montana Network to evaluate the spiritual health of the church with the Nine Healthy Church Targets survey?
